**BRAHMAN NASIONALE VEILING: DIE VOLGENDE
BEPALINGE IS VAN TOEPASSING OP DIE NASIONALE
VEILING**

1(a) Alle diere ingeskryf vir verkoop moet ten volle geregistreer wees.

2(a) Die veilingskomitee sal reëlings tref vir Plaas Inspeksie.

2(b) Alle veilingsdiere sal die dag voor die veiling (kyk weer) vir veilingsgereedheid en kwalifiserende standarde gekeur word deur die Beoordelaars soos aangewys deur die Raad.

2(c) Die teler beskik oor die reg van apel teen 'n afkeuring van 'n Veilingsdier op terme en voorwaardes soos deur die Raad bepaal. (Teen 'n koste soos deur die Raad bepaal).

2(d) Alle beeste ingeskryf moet in die verkoopsring gebring en te koop aangebied word, behalwe diere wat afgekeur is mag nie te koop aangebied word nie, selfs al verskyn hulle in die katalogus.

2(e) Die keurder het die reg om a.g.v. diskriminerende foute, al is dit nie diskwalifiserend nie, 'n dier af te keur vir die Nasionale Veiling.

3 Bulle mag nie jonger as **30** maande wees nie. Geen maksimum ouderdom is van toepassing nie.

4(a) Bulle wat aangebied word moet vrugbaar gesertifiseer word d.m.v. 'n vrugbaarheidstoets wat binne 30 dae van die veiling deur 'n Veearts gedoen is en sodanige sertifisering moet voor die finale keuring vir die veiling aan die Ras Direkteur oorhandig word.

4(b) Bulle moet ook deur 'n Veearts geslagsiekte-vry gesertifiseer word. Geldige skedewas sertifikate, TB en BM sertifikate moet voor die finale keuring vir die veiling ingehandig word.

4(c) Alle diere (manlik & vroulik) se DNS moet aangeteken wees by die Genootskap, asook vaderskap bevestiging.

5(a) Minimum ouderdom vir oop verse is 12 maande.

5(b) Alle vroulike diere ouer as 32 maande moet dragtig wees of met 'n kalf aangebied word. Dragtigheid moet deur 'n Veearts gesertifiseer word en sodanige sertifisering moet voor die finale keuring aan die Ras Direkteur oorhandig word. Koeie moet 'n TKP 485 dae handhaaf. LET WEL: Ingevolge die Genootskap se beleid moet 'n vers haar eerste kalf hê voor of op 43maande, ten einde te verseker dat die registrasiewaardigheid van sodanige dier nie gekanselleer word nie.

6. Geen dier mag in die Verkoopsring ingebring word tensy dit in die katalogus ingeskryf is nie. Geen vervanging van enige dier sal toegelaat word, nadat inskrywings in die katalogus gesluit het nie.

7. Inskrywingsfooie beloop R1200-00(btw ingesluit) per dier. **Semen** beloop R600(btw ingesluit) per inskrywing, **Semen per lot (1-20 stroootjies)** R600, 2de addisionele lot R600. Slegs semen afkomstig van geregistreerde KI-bulle sal te koop aangebied word. **Embrio inskrywing** beloop R600(btw ingesluit), (1-10 embrios), fooie is betaalbaar met inskrywing aan die Brahman Genootskap. **Inskrywingsfooie word vir promosie van die Nasionale Veiling aangewend en is onder geen omstandighede terugbetaalbaar nie, selfs al sou 'n dier kragtens 2(b) afgekeur word.**

8 Vir hierdie Nasionale Veiling sal die volgorde bepaal word volgens die gemiddeld van die twee hoogste pryse behaal op die 2025 veiling, hoogste gemiddelde prys eerste en laagste gemiddelde prys laaste. Alle nuwe toetreeders sal alfabeties op geregistreerde Lidnaam volg na 2025 se laaste deelnemer. Daar sal drie rondtes wees; eerste rondte 1 dier, tweede rondte 2 diere, derde rondte die res.

9. Die Raad sal jaarliks besluit wie die afslaers is vir die Nasionale Veiling.

10. Inskrywingsvorme moet vergesel word deur die voltooië vrywaringsvorm.

11. Kommissie van **8.5%** word oorbetaal aan die Afslaer.

12. Alle diere wat op 'n Nasionale Veiling, onder die beskerming van die Genootskap aangebied word, moet ondersteun word deur sy prestasie syfers (BTWs).

13. Inskrywings sluit **24 Julie 2026**.

14. Alle bulle wat op veiling kom moet voldoen aan die B-brand vereistes.

15. Diere moet ingeënt wees teen Bek-en-Klouseer binne 6 maande van veilings datum. Verkopers word vereis om Bek-en-Klouseer ent- bevestiging met die bondel nr en die entdatum in te dien vir die veiling. Indien diere verkoop word en is nie ingeënt teen Bek-en-Klou sal die dier/e slegs op die digitale platform aangebied word. Diere moet binne 3 dae voor die veiling afgteken word deur die kuddeveearts as vry van Bek-en-Klouseer.

BRAHMAN NATIONAL SALE: THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE APPLICABLE TO THE NATIONAL SALE

1(a) All animals entered for sale must be fully registered.

2(a) The auction committee will make arrangements for farm inspection.

2(b) All sale animals will receive a final screening the day before the sale for sale readiness and qualifying standards by the Judges as appointed by Council.

2(c) The member has the right to appeal against the rejection of a Sale Animal due to the terms and conditions as set by the Board. (At a fee determined by the Board)

2(d) All animals entered for sale must enter the sale ring and be offered, except in the case of animals rejected for sale readiness. Such animal(s) will not be permissible for sale even if such animal(s)' particulars appear in the catalogue.

2(e) The inspector has the right to as a result of discrimination, even if it is not a disqualification, reject an animal for the National Sale.

3 Bulls may not be younger than **30** months. No maximum age is applicable.

4(a) Bulls offered for sale must be certified as fertile by means of a fertility test by a Vet. Such a test must be performed within 30 days prior to the sale and the Certificate must be handed in to the Breed Director prior to the screening for the sale.

4(b) Bulls must also be certified by a Vet to be free of any venereal disease. Valid sheath wash certificates, TB & CA certificates must be handed in prior to the screening for the sale.

4(c) The DNA of all animals (male & female) must be recorded at the Society as well as sire verification.

5(a) Minimum age for open heifers is 12 months.

5(b) All female animals older than 32 months must be in calf or presented with a calf. Females must be certified pregnant by a vet, and such a certification must be handed to the Breed Director prior to the screening for the sale. Cows must maintain an ICP of 485 days. TAKE NOTE: According to the Society's policy a heifer must have had her first calf before or at 43 months, in order to ensure that registration worthiness of the animal is not cancelled.

6. No animal may enter the sales ring if not entered in the Sales Catalogue. No replacement of any animal will be permissible after entries have closed.

7. Entry fees amounts to R1200-00(vat inclusive) per animal, Semen amounts R600(vat inclusive), Semen per lot (1-20 straws R600), 2nd amounts to additional lot R600. Only semen collected from registered AI-bulls would be sold. Embryo entries amounts R600(vat inclusive), (1-10 Embryos) Entry fees and will need to accompany the entry

form and are payable to the Brahman Society. Entry fees will be used for the promotion of the National Sale and are not refundable, even if an animal is rejected in accordance with Clause 2(b).

8. For this National Sale the sequence will be determined to the average of the two highest prices attained at the 2025 sale, highest average price first and lowest average price will be last. All new entries will follow alphabetically according to registered Member name after the last 2025 participant. There will be three rounds; first round 1 animal, second round 2 animals, third round the rest.

9. Council will decide annually who the auctioneers for the National Sale will be.

10. Entry forms must be accompanied by the completed Indemnity forms.

11. Commission of **8.5%** will be paid to the Auctioneer.

12. All animals presented at the National Sale, under the auspices of the Society, must be supported by performance values (EBVs).

13. Entries close **24 Julie 2026**.

14. All sale bulls must conform to B-brand requirements.

15. Animals must be vaccinated against Foot-and-Mouth Disease within 6 months of the sale date. Sellers are required to submit Foot-and-Mouth Disease vaccination confirmation with the batch number and vaccination date for the sale. If animals are sold and haven't been vaccinated against Foot-and-Mouth Disease, the animal(s) will only be presented on the digital platform. Animals must be cleared by the herd veterinarian within 3 days before the sale to be free of Foot-and-Mouth Disease.
